#### **Position Highlights:**

- Core faculty members devote at least 15 hours/week to resident education and administration, evaluate competency domains, work closely with PD, assist in developing and implementing evaluation systems, and teach and advise residents
- Key Faculty contribute to graduate medical education through the primary role of precepting in the Residency Outpatient clinic – ratio approximately 4:1
- The IM Residency Program opened in July 2020 and is fully accredited. Our residents produce award-winning scholarship at local & regional levels
- Good Samaritan is a 156-bed level III Trauma Center, and Certified Primary Stroke Center serving a quarter of a million people throughout southern Indiana and Illinois
